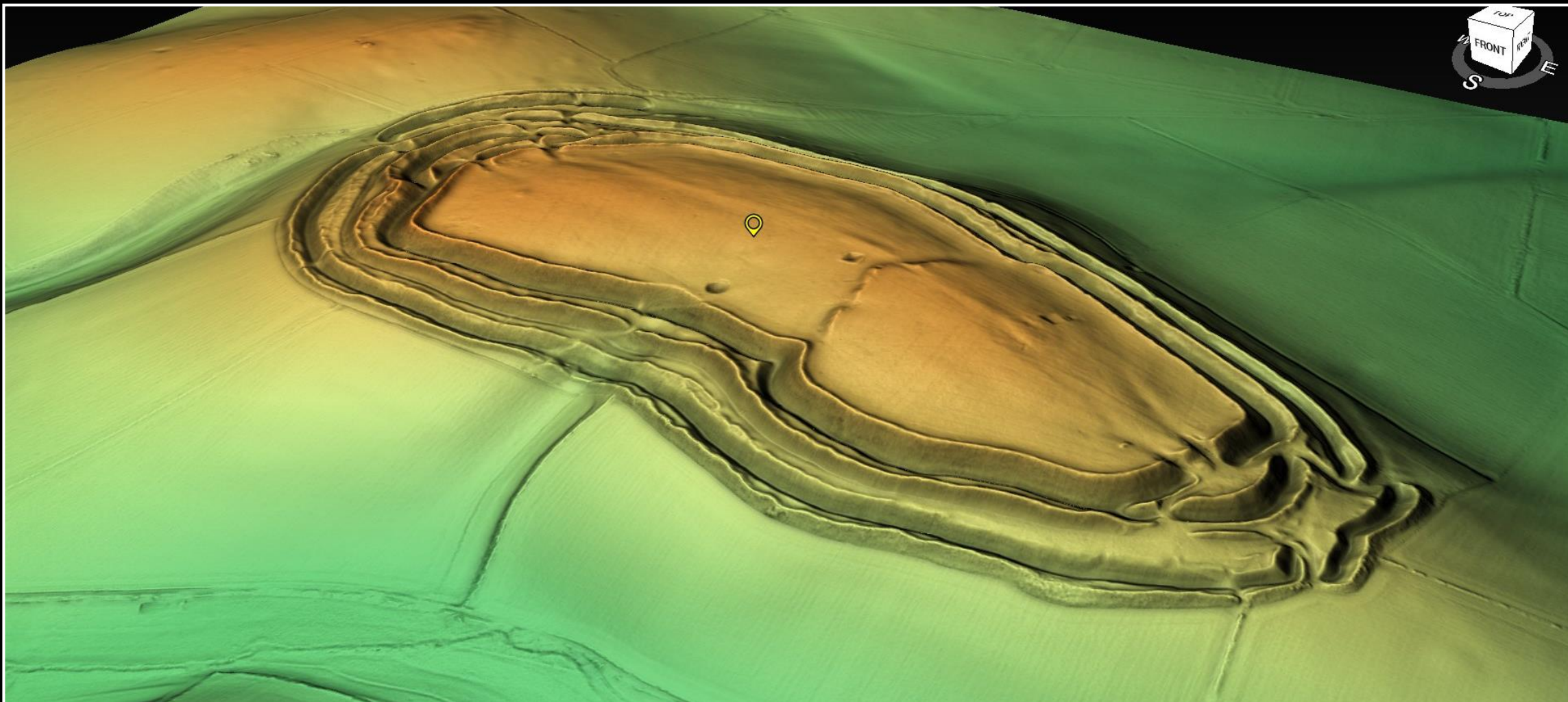

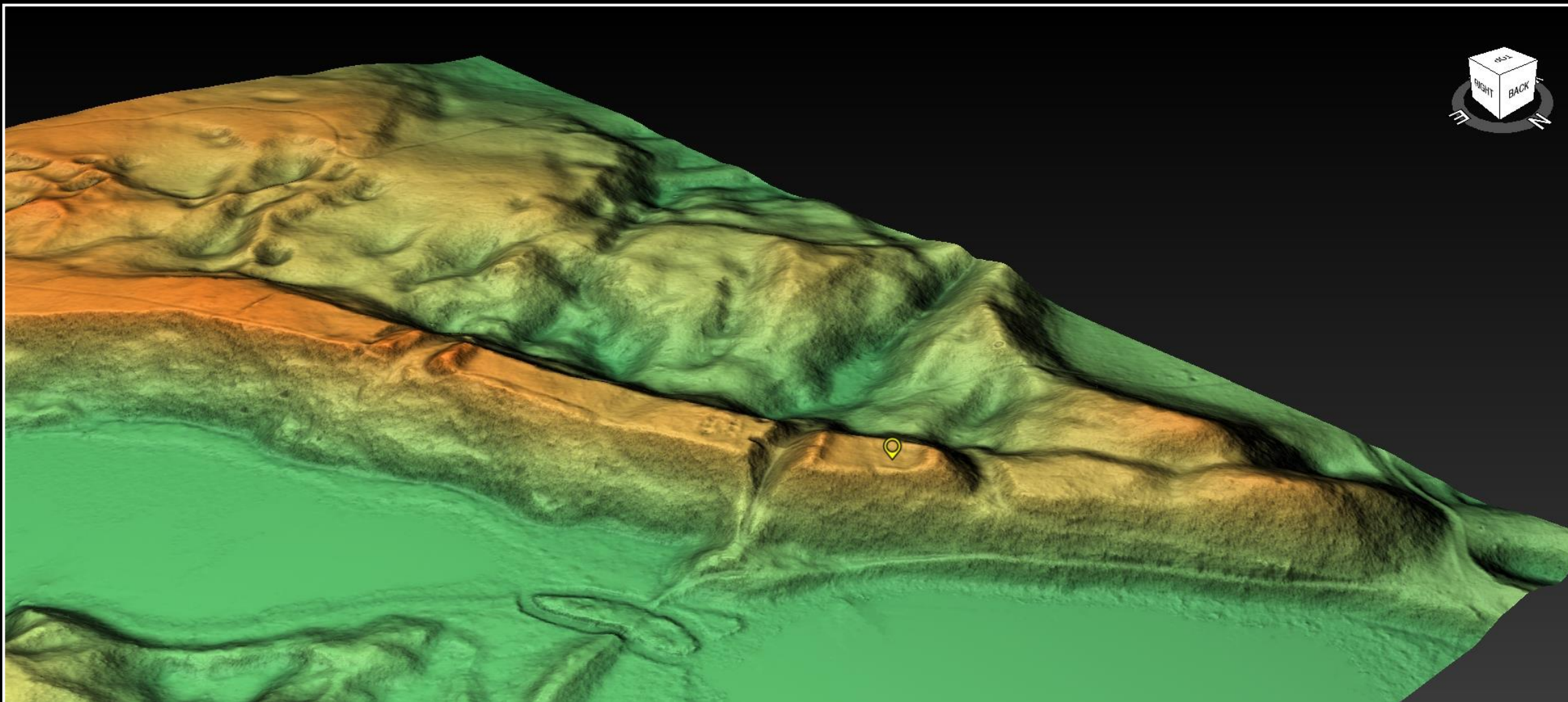

The Atlas of Hillforts of Britain and Ireland was produced as part of a four year collaborative project between archaeologists at the University of Edinburgh and the University of Oxford, assisted by colleagues at University College Cork for Ireland. The project was funded by the Arts and Humanities Research Council (Grant Ref: AH/J004499/1) and was led by Professor Gary Lock (School of Archaeology, University of Oxford) and Professor Ian Ralston (Abercromby Professor of Archaeology, University of Edinburgh). Partners included English Heritage (now Historic England), Historic Environment Scotland especially the former Royal Commission on the Ancient and Historical Monuments of Scotland, The Royal Commission on the Ancient and Historical Monuments of Wales, Department of the Environment (Northern Ireland) and the Hillfort Study Group.
